Accident, Critical Illness, and Hospital Indemnity coverage are designed to supplement your medical plan by providing direct payments to you. These payouts do not have to be used toward medical bills; they are paid directly to your bank account and can be used however you choose—such as deductibles, copays, transportation, childcare, groceries, or everyday expenses.

➤ Accident Insurance

Accident insurance can help offset out-of-pocket costs after a covered accident, such as fractures, dislocations, burns, emergency room visits, ambulance services, or follow-up care. This benefit can be especially helpful for families with active lifestyles, children in sports, or anyone who wants additional support beyond their medical plan.

➤ Critical Illness Insurance

Critical illness insurance can provide added support if you are diagnosed with a covered serious health condition, such as a heart attack, stroke, major organ failure, or certain cancers. This coverage can be especially helpful because serious illnesses often bring more than medical concerns—they may also require additional appointments, time away from work, travel for care, or extra support during recovery.

➤ Hospital Indemnity Insurance

Hospital indemnity insurance applies when hospitalization occurs for a covered stay – including admissions related to pregnancy and childbirth. This coverage may help ease the financial impact of inpatient admission, extended hospital stays, intensive care stays, or other covered hospital-related services.

➤ Health Screening Benefit

If you enroll in eligible voluntary benefits, you are also eligible to receive a health screening benefit for completing certain covered preventive screenings. The health screening benefit pays \$75 per covered dependent, per plan. Examples may include routine blood tests, dental exams, mammograms, colonoscopies, stress tests, or other eligible screenings, depending on the plan.
